The Role:

In the role of Lifeguard, primary duties include overseeing swimmer safety, rescue operations and staying alert to their surroundings.



Key Tasks

Specific Duties will include:

- Interact with the public responsibly and welcome all users of the facility in a professional manner as a representative of The King's Foundation.
- Reception cover, including cash handling, as part of work rotation.
- Comply with all Pool Operating Procedures.
- To maintain a vigilant watch of the swimming pool areas in accordance with the operating procedures and take necessary action to ensure safety of all pool users and staff.
- Carry out rescues as required.
- To check the safety of equipment in areas of responsibility and report any damage or malfunction of equipment to the pool supervisor/duty officer. Ensure the facility is maintained to a high standard of cleanliness and hygiene at all times.
- Assist with the supervision of the children's activities and parties.
- Assist in the preparation and operation of events/activities, including set up and dismantling of equipment as directed by the pool supervisor/duty officer.
- To assist with the opening and closing of the pool.
- To attend CPD and training sessions as necessary.

Person Specification

The essential skills, knowledge and experience required are:

- Must hold a current National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (NPLQ)
- Skill in the application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques.
- Customer service focussed and excellent communication skills.
- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations.
- Knowledge of First Aid and CPR.
- Be able to work a variable shift pattern including weekend, early morning or evening shifts.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and be a good team player.
- Prepared to undertake swim teacher training and assist with swim lessons.

Other:

- The post will be based at The Tamar Manoukian Swimming Pool, New Cumnock, KA18 4AN.
- Variable hours contract. Weekend work will be required on a rotational shift basis.
- You must have the legal right to work in the UK.
